What kind of music? From Duke Ellington to Russia's Shostakovich, from Marches to Big Band and Light Classical, the PCCB plays an eclectic blend of modern, classical, swing and jazz that can best be described as the type of music played by the Boston Pops. You will be both entertained and uplifted while hearing the band. To enhance the experience, Director Kenneth Bell often includes ballet dancers, choral groups and instrumental soloists. This blending of the arts results in a wonderful treat for both eye and ear.

About the Band: The Pacific Coast Concert Band was formed in 1983 and has performed over 300 concerts in concert halls, band shells, and parks. Over the years, the band has evolved and now consists of a select group of musicians, many who have had professional music careers and many who teach local music students. Our musicians play in several area orchestras and bands. We are proud to be celebrating our 26th Anniversary.

The PCCB traditionally plays for community events and celebrations, outdoors and in the concert hall. Summertime the band performs in neighborhood parks in free public concerts. We perform annually at Oceanside's Days of Art Festival, Coronado Island's Promenade Concerts Series, Pomerado Band Festival in Poway, and a Holiday concert at the Carlsbad Community Cultural Arts Center.

We support music in our public schools with concerts and avenues of support to students. The Pacific Coast Concert Band is offered as a performance arts course in the Vista Adult Education curriculum.

Meet Our Conductor

Kenneth Bell brings a wide range of musical experience to the Pacific Coast Concert Band and has served as our Conductor/ Musical Director since April 1992.

He is a versatile performer, with a long history of musical achievement. He was a concert band conductor, French horn instructor and drum major at the Armed Forces School of Music, has performed as narrator with the chamber ensemble Camarada and the San Diego Symphony and is Assistant Conductor for the LaJolla Symphony Chorus.

Mr. Bell has directed church choir programs from coast to coast. As a basso-cantante, he has sung leading

roles in opera, performed oratorio, recital, off-Broadway, and musical theater for over 25 years. He has performed over eighty major roles, with over forty opera and theater companies, including New York City Opera, San Francisco Opera, Chicago Opera Theater, and the Spoleto Festival in Italy.

Mr. Bell has also performed with the New York Philharmonic at Lincoln Center, Musica Sacra, New England Bach Festival, Abbey Singers and was a member of the Waverly Consort for seven years. His performances have taken him throughout the Americas, Italy and Madeira. Kenneth and his wife, Dianne have lived in Vista, California since 1988.
